Already 60 years old, he left quite a legacy in the rural community of Craigmore, not only for his community involvements, but also as a country preacher. To this day, the church he founded, Craigmore United Church, is a well-known marker on the Snake Plain Trail near the North Saskatchewan River. Carl Krause stumbled on to this marker several years ago and decided to find out why it was there. The result is the book *Benjamin Ralph: "One of God's Gentlemen"*.
